NEEDS: In the past I have hinted to the fact that we need help, and we do! We would like you to pray that God may touch someone's heart (maybe even yours) to come down and help us. We are looking to the Lord for guidance and are open to whatever He does. As we see it, there are several possibilities.

1. **Most urgent! Teacher. Short term (6 months to one yr)** We need someone to help with teaching our son's. If at all possible, starting this August. Here are a few possibilities:
 - a. **A young lady**, that could come and aid in the boy's schooling (they use video courses), primarily in developing their English understanding. Also, helping my wife (Zirlene) develop her English as well.
 - b. This could also be done by a **widow**.
 - c. **Or a couple**. They could help in other areas as well.
2. **Long term.** (Hopefully, permanently).
 - a. **A back-up team. (Preferably a family)** Which could help share the diverse aspects of this ministry. (Maintenance, landscape, farming, building, music, teaching my boy's, etc...) This would relieve me to spend more time with what is more important.
 - b. **A missionary family. This would be the greatest of my desires.** A family to help in all and every area of the ministry. Someone to share the work, joys and burdens with. To help develop the training center. To leave here when we go on furlough, and vice-versa. To witness, sing, preach, and teach.
