We now need \$7,500 to complete the funds needed for our house and moving expenses. What a blessing to see the Lord work so quickly in peoples hearts! We praise the LORD for you that have given and helped us with this need. I ask you again to pray about what God would have you to do to help us with this need.

The children are enjoying the summer riding bikes and playing at the parks near our house. This is a great opportunity for us to talk to other children and to invite them to church. It also is a great way for the children to continue learning Korean. Please pray for all of us as we learn the Korean language. Joshua is excited about joining Elisabeth's Korean class. A lady in our church has been teaching Elisabeth since we came to Korea. This week is Joshua's first time to join the class.
