I am to talk with the owner of another building in town in two weeks regarding the lease of his building. Suffice it to say it will be a large improvement on what we currently have! I ask you to pray for God's will. I will tell you all about it next month if God allows it to go through.

The greatest blessing of late is that I have been able to see some people come to Christ in the past couple weeks, which is also an answer to prayer. I was able to lead two young ladies to Christ while helping Missionary Steve Harris in Magdalena de Kino, which is about 40 miles from our church. One of them is 15 years old, named Ytsel, and the other is 19 years old, named Alma. I have rarely found anyone as willing to receive the Gospel as Alma was that day. It was obvious that God had been preparing her heart for that conversation! Along those lines, please pray for Andrew. He is 20 years old, and in the past has not been ready to accept Christ when I witnessed to him, but I have heard some things about him that show me that God is preparing his heart also. Please pray! Another blessing is that a man visiting our church recently accepted Christ during the invitation time, and has been coming to the Sunday morning services for the past three weeks. His name is Roy; please mention him also as you pray for us.
